

Member Resignation/Removal from Office

A Board of Education position is deemed vacant upon any one of the following events:

1. The death of the incumbent
2. A member's resignation
3. A member's removal from office
4. A member being and remaining continuously absent from the District for period extending sixty (60) days or ceasing to be a resident of the District
5. Other causes as defined by State Statute 17.03

In addition, a Board of Education position may become temporarily vacant as per Wis. Stats. 17.035 if the Board member shall enter the armed forces of the United States and shall remove himself/herself from the Board temporarily.

When a Board member does decide to terminate his/her service to the District, the Board of Education requests the earliest possible notification of intent to resign so that appropriate plans can be made.
