Curriculum Committee Meeting Friday, October 4, 2019 District Board Room 10:30 a.m.

Chair Heidi Hartz called the meeting to order.

Dr. Garvey verified that the meeting was properly posted pursuant to § 19.84(1) Wis. Statutes.

Motion by Malueg/Hartz to adopt the agenda with moving agenda item #8 before item #5. Motion Carried.

Motion by Malueg/Johnson to accept the administrators' recommendation to decline the creation of a Drama Club as the proposed activities are part of the theatre club. Motion Carried.

Motion by Malueg/Johnson to accept the administrators' recommendation to decline creating a History Club and recommend that the History department propose their travel opportunities through the field trip process. Motion Carried.

Motion by Hartz/Johnson to recommend to the Board that a Mock Trial team be approved. Motion Carried.

Data Analysis

Dr. Garvey led the presentation of standardized test (ACT, AP, Forward, Aspire) results and the history of each. The administrators prepared a trend of each as requested and presented hard copies.

Dr. Garvey and the administrative team shared their belief that standardized tests are not valid ways to evaluate students nor Districts. Dr. Garvey shared many points where standardized tests actually work against the personalized learning on which the District's instructional practices are based.

Dr. Garvey confirmed with the Committee members that there was still support to continue with the District's Personalized Learning instructional practices. These practices rely on MAP scores and not one-time standardized tests like ACT and Forward.

Portrait of a Graduate

The Committee will meet with the Administrative team and Dr. Ryan Krohn who will assist the District leaders with developing "A Portrait of a Graduate" representing the educational development of all students.

The next meeting will be Wednesday, November 13th at 8 a.m. in the elementary principal's office. Elementary Instruction will be the showcase.
