
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF JOHNSON CREEK BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY

High Honor Roll/Honor Roll Status

To be eligible for High Honor Roll/Honor Roll a student must be enrolled for a minimum of **two** credits at Johnson Creek High School per semester. These credits can be a combination of classes from Johnson Creek High School and other approved post secondary schools. Exceptions must be approved by the high school principal and district administrator who must be notified prior to the end of each grading period.

High Honor Roll requires a 3.5 - 4.00 GPA per semester. Honor Roll requires a 3.0 - 3.49 GPA per semester.



Postsecondary credits will be combined with those from Johnson Creek High School when the student presents an official grade report to the school counselor. In almost all instances this will be at semester's end. Should a postsecondary institution be on a trimester schedule, we shall compute the grades for honor/high honor roll to the nearest next Johnson Creek High School quarter's end.
