

### **College and Career Readiness**

Each student K-8 will have a Student Proficiency Profile detailing academic process. These are ongoing electronic progress scales available for parents and student.

Beginning in 6<sup>th</sup> grade, students create and maintain an academic and career planning portfolio. Students in 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> along with parents shall meet with the guidance counselor for education and career planning.

Johnson Creek Students are exposed to career options through guest speakers, field trips, and projects. Middle School students are exposed to career and technical education classes. High school courses are offered in career and technical education. Students also can participate in work-based learning programs and youth apprenticeships.

Graduates will participate in an exit interview as a graduation requirement. Surveys will be developed and sent to graduates one year after graduating and five years after graduating. These surveys should be answered voluntarily and provide input/feedback on the quality of their education.

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
