

Item 6 –Activity and Program Report (Dec 2012 / Jan 2013)

a. **Communication –**

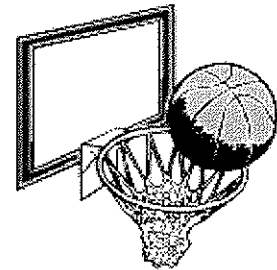
Met with **Elissa Meltesen** - Elissa has made changes to the Village web site to make it easier to find the recreation department web site. There are now four ways in which someone may locate a link to the recreation website from the Village website. Item #1 and #2 are new access points that are added, #3 and #4 were existing access points on the site. Locate a "link" by:

1. Click Departments, then click Recreation – Joint Recreation Department
2. Click Quick Links, then click Recreation Department
3. Click Departments, then click on Parks, then click on the JCre Department link
4. Click on Services, then Click Related Links, then click Johnson Creek Schools – Recreation Department.

b. Met with librarian **Luci Bledsoe**; Discussion on possible joint programs. Safety Fair mentioned, with J-C Chamber (**Leigh Price**) participating; Fourth of July Carnival is another. Post schedule of recreation events and registration information at library to reach out to "home" and parochial school families and strive to avoid conflicts regarding dates and times for special events. Recent on-going communication via email.

c. **Youth Basketball –**

Combined program for **1st and 2nd grade boys and girls** - Twelve children have registered. Smaller balls and lower rims will be used to avoid bad form and habits; **start-up meeting Saturday, January 19; Paul Ganser** to offer instruction for a 6 week program; purchased appropriate sized balls and participant t-shirts; Purchased wall mount storage rack for recreation basketball program.



Combined program for **K-grade boys and girls** - Will purchase 7 inch diameter balls; Use existing Elem MPR adjustable basketball hoops for K-Group; **Target February/March for sign-ups and instruction.**

Basketball Grades 3-6 boys & girls – First Games Saturday, January 5

- Fifth & sixth grade basketball - separate boy and girl basketball league; 18 boys (2 teams) and 16 girls (2 teams).
- Third & fourth grade basketball – Separate league for girls and boys; 16 girls (2 teams) and 10 boys (1 team) have registered. Total participants = 60.

Basketball Clinic for Girls ended December 8; Thirty-one participants.

Sport Clinics – Future endeavor is to lay the groundwork for school sport coaches to offer instruction to youth players and REC coaches that reflect the developmental needs and interests of their given sport.
