Curriculum Committee Meeting Minutes  
Wednesday, March 19, 2008  
4:00 p.m.

Chair Kellie Loeb called the meeting to order at 4:05 p.m.

Present: Kellie Loeb, Don Battenberg, Tina Roehl, District Administrator Michael P. Garvey and Elementary Principal Kristine Blakeley

Dr. Garvey verified that the meeting had been properly posted.

Moved by Battenberg/Roehl to adopt the agenda as posted. Motion passed.

Mrs. Blakeley presented the 4K goals and concepts. She explained that they are centered around the Wisconsin Early Learning Standards and that the curriculum will be fleshed out by a team of teachers which includes 4K, K and 1<sup>st</sup> grade.

The Committee endorsed the curriculum goals as presented.

Dr. Garvey and Mrs. Blakeley discussed curriculum revisions and summer curriculum plans.

They proposed and received Committee endorsement to offer curriculum time to health, social studies/history and career and technical education (FACE, Ag, business, tech. ed.). Mrs. Loeb asked about work-study programs and Dr. Garvey indicated that he is working with School-to-Work Coordinator Chris Klatt on defining our program. Mr. Battenberg asked about the other core subject areas.

Dr. Garvey and Mrs. Blakeley responded with their second proposal which received Committee endorsement. They wish to offer a Curriculum Academy to provide teams time to work on the next phase of curriculum development. Math, science and reading/language arts have had summer curriculum projects over the past two summers. The Curriculum Academy would provide teams from these areas to work on further development.

Moved by Roehl/Battenberg to adjourn at 5:03 p.m. Motion passed.
