Because the Personnel Committee specifically wanted to insure that the IT work was not taking away from instruction time a new vendor was sought. Dr. Garvey will interview both companies and select which one will meet the District needs. He explained the terms of the contracts and the Board will take action at the July Board meeting.

Krohn has a 90% contract based upon \$88,000 (\$79,200)She will be given the option to stay at 90% or increase her percentage up to 100%. If she chooses to increase her percentage, more of her time will be scheduled in the building and an increase of day to day responsibilities will be assigned. The nature of the responsibilities will be developed if she chooses to increase her contract percentage.
