Extracurricular and Interscholastic Programs

POLICY: 370

The Board believes that student activities at school are a vital part of the total K-12 educational program and should be used as a means for developing wholesome attitudes and good human relations, as well as knowledge and skills. The Board believes that school citizenship, as reflected in student activities, is a measure of the achievement of important school goals. The Board recognizes that the greatest values are derived from both curricular and extracurricular student school activities when such activities are encouraged through participation.

The Board further believes that any program of student activities should:

- 1. Require all student participation to be on a voluntary basis.
- 2. Require that student activity funds should be used for purposes which benefit the student body of the school.

It is the policy of the School District of Johnson Creek pursuant to Wis. Stats. 118.13, and PI 9, that no person on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional and learning disability, may be denied admission to any school in this district or be denied participation in, or the benefits of, or be discriminated against in any curricular, extra-curricular, pupil services, recreational, or other program.

Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
