

Student Scholarships

Students in the district shall be informed by the school counselor of any available academic scholarships.

Information concerning available scholarships shall be posted in the school counseling office and on the counseling website. The high school counselor shall maintain records of available scholarships and shall notify students of such scholarship opportunities.

In order for a student to be eligible for scholarships sponsored through or by the district, he/she shall have been a student in the Johnson Creek High School for the last two full semesters before graduating from Johnson Creek High School. This includes the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship.

Students attending Johnson Creek High School fulltime under Wisconsin's Open Enrollment law shall be eligible for scholarships on the same basis as resident students.

The district shall not discriminate in the selection of student scholarships on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, color, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
