

Use of Tobacco on School Premises at Public Functions

Smoking and Other Tobacco Use

State statute prohibits the use of tobacco products on school property.

The Johnson Creek Board of Education prohibits the use of all tobacco products on school property and at school events at all times. This ban extends to all activities both during and outside of the regular school day and term and to all events, activities, and meetings that may occur during the calendar year. This prohibition on the use of tobacco products extends to all district-owned buildings, grounds, and vehicles wherever they may be.

Tobacco/Smoking products include but not limited to:

- Smoking materials (cigarettes, cigars, pipes, etc.)
- Non smoke tobacco products (chewing tobacco, snuff, etc.)
- Electronic vapor smoking devices (e-cigarettes, vapor pipes, etc.)

For offenses against this prohibition, the crowd-control employee or event supervisor shall request immediate cessation of the offending activity according to the terms of this policy. Refusal to do so or repetition of the behavior at the same activity shall be reported to the crowd-control officer who shall escort the offender from the activity and school premises.

The Board of Education issues this ban in a sincere appeal to all supporters of the district's educational programs to cooperate in helping to create on our premises a truly healthy environment for all concerned.

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
