

Public Solicitation in the Schools

The School District of Johnson Creek recognizes the community and social value of humanitarian agencies and their need for financial support. Thus, educating pupils of the services performed and the need to participate in their financial support, are encouraged. However, to insure that students or school personnel are not exploited in efforts to gain financial support for these organizations, the District shall not permit nonschool organizations to use school time, facilities, personnel, or students for collection, sale, merchandising, or any form of solicitation, except when authorized by the building principal.

The District will allow contractual relationships with vendors to merchandise products to students and personnel for the purpose of group purchasing, such as class rings, yearbooks, photographs, and other group purchases of products and services. Vendors shall not, however, be permitted to contact students or school personnel during school hours, except when authorized by the building principal.
