Curriculum Committee Meeting Minutes Tuesday, March 4, 2008 3:30 p.m. High School IMC

Chair Kellie Loeb called the meeting to order.

Members present: Kellie Loeb, Don Battenberg, Tina Roehl (around 4:10)

Also present: Board President Jamie Hombsch, District Administrator Michael Garvey, Principal Eric Ranzen, Health Teacher Marcus Novak, Summer School Director Chris Klatt, and Agriculture Instructor Ed Bielinski

Dr. Garvey verified that the meeting was properly posted.

Moved by Battenberg/Loeb to adopt the agenda as posted. Motion passed.

Dr. Garvey presented an opportunity to partner with AAA of Wisconsin to offer driver's education at Johnson Creek High School during the summer and possibly on evenings during the school year.

Moved by Battenberg/Loeb to recommend to the full Board that the District partner with AAA to provide driver's education and that the 10% refund be passed on to District students and the refund from the enrollment of any non-district students would help defray any cost the District may encumber. Motion passed.

The Committee reviewed a proposal concerning a change in the Health Curriculum.

Moved by Battenberg/Roehl to endorse a change in the Health Curriculum to replace the current structure (7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> grade Health) with an 8<sup>th</sup> grade semester class, a 10<sup>th</sup> grade Life After High School class and a change to the Econ course to include personal finance. Motion passed.

NOTE: 2008-09 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the semester course. Econ will be modified.

2009-2010 the 10<sup>th</sup> grade course would be in place.

The Committee discussed summer school with Mr. Klatt.

Moved by Battenberg/Roehl to set June 23-July 3 and July 14-24, 2008 (Monday-Thursday with no classes July 4-13) as the 2008 summer school dates. Motion passed.

The Committee reviewed the Agriculture Curriculum with Ag Instructor Ed Bielinski. Moved by Roehl/Loeb to recommend to the Board for adoption. Motion passed.

Dr. Garvey presented a recommendation to the Committee to address the lost instructional time due to the December roof collapse at the jr./sr. high.

Moved by Roehl/Battenberg to recommend to the full Board that the District address the lost instructional time by

- ✓ Requesting a waiver from the DPI to the 180 day rule
- ✓ Replace the teacher grading inservice day scheduled for April 7 with an instructional day at the jr./sr. high school (elementary would still have a teacher grading/inservice day on April 7)
- ✓ The early release days scheduled for April 23 and May 13 with full instructional days
- ✓ Add 10 minutes to the jr./sr. high school day

Motion passed.

Moved by Roehl/Battenberg to adjourn.
